Any personnel required to inspect a broad range of PPE relating to work at height, including: Textiles (harnesses, lanyards, slings, rope, energy absorbers), Hardware (connectors, devices, pulleys, wire strops) and helmets.

Delivery Method:

This course is classroom based involving presentations followed by extensive hand's on inspection of equipment.

Equipment:

All equipment is provided for this course. Students are welcome to bring with them any specialist equipment as used in their workplace to discuss the specific inspection requirements.

Assessment:

Course content is assessed by a combination of direct observations and by means of a practical exam where students inspect and record their findings for 30 various items of work at height PPE. Individual feedback is available.

Certification:

Students will receive a digital Outreach Rescue certificate of achievement upon meeting assessment criteria. Results are recorded on a personal record of performance and recorded on the Outreach Rescue Database.

Certification is valid for 3 years.

Progression:

Recertification & Refresher training is recommended every 2 years.
