

Safe Work at Height & Rope Rescue Operator Recertification

Who Should Attend:

Rope Operators who are approaching their award expiry or those who require refresher training as a SWAH and Rope Rescue Operator.

Pre-Requisites or APL:

Previously completed a SWAH and Rope Rescue Operator course or equivalent

Requirements:

- Consolidated experience of operating at the SWAH and Rope Operator level
- 🧏 Fit for operational duties
- Physical fitness for potentially strenuous training

Aim:

To re-establish students competence and to deliver refresher training to existing SWAH and Rope Rescue Operators.

Outcomes:

On successful completion of the course, the student will have demonstrated competence in their knowledge and skills and be able to:

- Apply knowledge of rescue equipment; use, care, application and maintenance
- Assess hazards associated with use of rope systems and create appropriate responses
- Understand theory of fall prevention and hierarchy of safety systems
- Demonstrate understanding of legal requirements and Health and Safety as applied to rope rescue situations including basic casualty care and skills maintenance
- Demonstrate safe application of a range of technical rescue equipment and its application within the basic systems for rescue and twin line working: Anchoring, belaying, abseiling, rope ascent, lowering, raising. and working on structures

Duration:

3 days with 21 hours contact time

Ratios:

Trainers 1:6 Students

Delivery Method:

Lectures, classroom work, practical sessions and scenario based training.

Equipment:

Specialist equipment and PPE is included. You can provide your own PPE provided it is serviceable subject to inspection by our trainers.

Clothing suitable for working outdoors in all weather will be required, as well as gloves suitable for rope work.

Assessment:

Course content is assessed by a combination of direct observations of set tasks, question and answer, written/multi choice exams and scenario-based assessment. Individual feedback is provided.

Certification:

Students will receive a digital Outreach Rescue certificate of achievement upon meeting assessment criteria. Results are recorded on a personal record of performance and recorded on the Outreach Rescue Database.

Certification is valid for 3 years.

Progression:

Recertification & Refresher training is recommended every 2 years.
