

WATER RESCUE 'ADVANCED' TECHNICAL SKILLS REASSESSMENT

Who should attend

Emergency Service personnel who require reassessment as an Outreach Water Rescue Advanced Technical Skills.

Course/Programme Requirements

- Students must have successfully completed the Outreach Water Rescue Advanced technical Skills (or Reassessment course) within the previous 2 years with verified maintenance of skills.
- Compliance with Outreach Training Progression Policy.
- Be fit for full operational duties in accordance with organisation requirements.
- Have received formal training in Health and Safety at Work, including manual handling.

The module will involve students undertaking potentially strenuous training in and out of water.

All specialist equipment required is provided. Service uniform is not required.

Aim

To reassess students in the required core skills and understanding associated with working near water hazards and undertaking suitable rescues where difficult access, complex rope work or night work is involved.

Outcomes

After successful completion of the course, the student will be able to:

- Apply knowledge of rope and other equipment; its selection, care and application for water access systems.
- Apply a selection of rope tensioning systems.
- Employ a variety anchors and belay procedures.
- Demonstrate use of personal quick-release systems in water

- Employ cableways and vertical access for casualty extraction.
- Demonstrate use of stretchers in horizontal and vertical configurations
- Apply cableways for boat lowers.
- Apply the fundamentals of search operations and management including night search in water

Delivery Method

By lectures, practical exercises and scenarios.

Assessment/Certification/Accreditation

Core content is assessed by a combination of continuous, scenario based assessments and written work to inform the student's development indicators. Results centrally recorded and entered in a personal Record of Performance.

Students will receive Outreach Rescue Certification on successful completion. It is recommended that a reassessment is attended within 2 years and that adequate skills maintenance will have been undertaken in the interim.
