Delivered at our training centre or your chosen location (subject to site suitability), these audits ensure your team is prepared for workplace emergencies.

Compliance:

Aligns with relevant workplace legislation and guidance applicable to the client's operations.

Previous knowledge:

No specific knowledge is required, though participants being familiar with existing rescue plans and procedures is beneficial.

Requirements:

Venues must meet safety and suitability standards for realistic scenario execution.

Progression:

Annual audits or advanced training to address identified gaps.

- Review of current procedures and rescue plans.
- Compliance with workplace safety legislation.
